Costs & Housing & Textbooks - Approx. \$200 for 15 nights of lodging and approx. \$125 for course materials. Meals - Over half of the meals are provided free, the remainder are on your own. Tuition & Scholarships - Approx. \$1,485 for academic credit (\$495/hour); \$350 for audit credit.

- Olivet Students: \$600 scholarships, so tuition cost is \$885.*
- Visiting Students: \$900 scholarships, so tuition cost is \$585.*
- Additional Financial Assistance: may be available based upon need.

Due to the small size and rigorous nature of the Institute, the Center for Law and Culture retains complete discretion to determine which applicants are accepted into the program. For students accepted into the program, the \$250 deposit secures enrollment and will be deducted from the Institute's tuition cost. In the event an applicant is not accepted into the program, the Center will promptly refund the applicant's \$250 deposit. **Students desiring to attend the Institute should apply as soon as possible because the Center uses a rolling admissions approach** (i.e., highly qualified students are accepted as they apply). To encourage early applications, tuition will be reduced by \$50 for visiting (non-Olivet) students taking the Institute for academic credit who have mailed this form on or before Friday, March 24, 2023. The balance of tuition is due on or before Monday, May 1. Students accepted into the program for academic credit who withdraw on or before this date forfeit the \$250 registration deposit. Those who withdraw on or after Tuesday, May 9, without valid extenuating circumstances, forfeit a total of \$495.
